The Mission Director has sent us the following brief description:



*The young Diocese of Kohima, in the northeast of India, has over 60,000 Catholic converts belonging to 15 major tribes, each with its own distinct tradition, culture and dialect. The lay leaders, especially the full time and part time catechists, are in the forefront of evangelization as they contact new villages and tirelessly work to preach and convert. The Church is actively involved in the everyday life of the people and has achieved much in other forms of apostolate like education, health care, self-help projects, rehabilitation of the sick, the orphans, and the drug addicts. Much remains to be done for this interior and under-developed region and that is possible through the generosity of Catholics like you who join the Church's mission of evangelization through your contribution, prayer and support. #### LITTLE THINGS IMPACT KIDS FAITH DEVELOPMENT

One of my former colleagues had a favorite expression, "Don't sweat the little things. Life is really just a bunch of little things." Parents may translate this into the child raising admonition to "pick your battles" – choosing not to argue with children over irritating yet inconsequential acts, and focusing efforts instead on changing habits or practices that may have lifelong, negative repercussions.

I do not know that this philosophy holds true in matters in faith, though. I am starting to think that it is the little things we do in our faith life that will provide the greatest dividend to our children. Consider the rather small weekly investment of time required to worship weekly.

As a relatively experienced religious educator, I had no delusions about the Mass attendance of our students. Still, I was disheartened when one class was polled on whether they attended Mass weekly. Less than 20 percent did. The question about praying before meals was met with the same dismal response. I trust these statistics are an aberration, but I fear they may not be too far off the mark within many Catholic communities, regardless of the socioeconomic background, parish size, or other qualifying factors.

Attendance at religious education classes (or a parochial school) is an important component in the faith development of children, but its potential to help build a long-term spiritual relationship with God is jeopardized when not accompanied by regular participation at Mass. Is it better than no religious instruction at all? Absolutely, but why not give a child the added benefits of gaining a deeper understanding of our faith and sharing it with the greater Catholic community at Mass.

For those who do attend Mass regularly as a family, one of the smallest extras can be getting to church early. Try to focus not on the time Mass begins, but on the time necessary to leave the house in order to arrive at Mass with a comfortable cushion of time remaining. If we aim to be on time for the weekly basketball game, shouldn't we show at least the same amount of respect for church?

Imparting faith to children extends beyond Mass. Again, it can be small gestures that have the greatest impact. My friend Kris makes the sign of the cross on her children's forehead each morning. She wants them to consciously know that God is with them throughout the day and will help them handle whatever challenges school may introduce.

My sister in law Kathy starts her children's day with an informal prayer asking God to help them to do what he wants them to do. In the evening, they do an inventory of their actions that day and again ask God to help them make the right choices (one of my favorite themes in child raising).

# Stewardship Matters

"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." With these words, Jesus sent His disciples to the far ends of the earth to evangelize and bring the faith to the many people they encountered. Blessed John Paul II delivered a homily directed to that exact statement in November 2004.

As is the case with sermons given by the Pope, that message was meant for all of us. John Paul II made it clear that all of us were the laborers. He also explained that the world was still filled with souls who had not heard nor understood the message. Perhaps centuries had passed, but we still needed to be "heralds and witnesses" to the faith, as there is a "sense of need for Christ" rising up from the people of the world.

In Matthew's relating of this incident, Matthew quotes Jesus as saying, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send our laborers." The point is clear to us as stewards of the Church: first, we must recognize our role as evangelizers, as laborers in the harvest, by living out our faith as examples of Christian witness; second, we need to pray, consistently and constantly, for as John Paul II went on to say in that homily, "Prayer moves the heart of God."
